- Have a first mortgage that was originated before January 21, 2020.
- Have experienced financial hardship (i.e. a 10% decrease in annual income or 10% increase in household expenses since March 2020).
- Have less than \$25,000 in assets (i.e. retirement, savings, pension) or less than five times your monthly mortgage payment.
- Have a mortgage with one of the qualifying mortgage servicers on our website.
- Meet the maximum annual household income requirements:

- Work with Hawai'i Community Lending's Mortgage Loan Consultants to obtain up to \$30,000 to pay your past due mortgage or reduce your monthly mortgage payment.
